



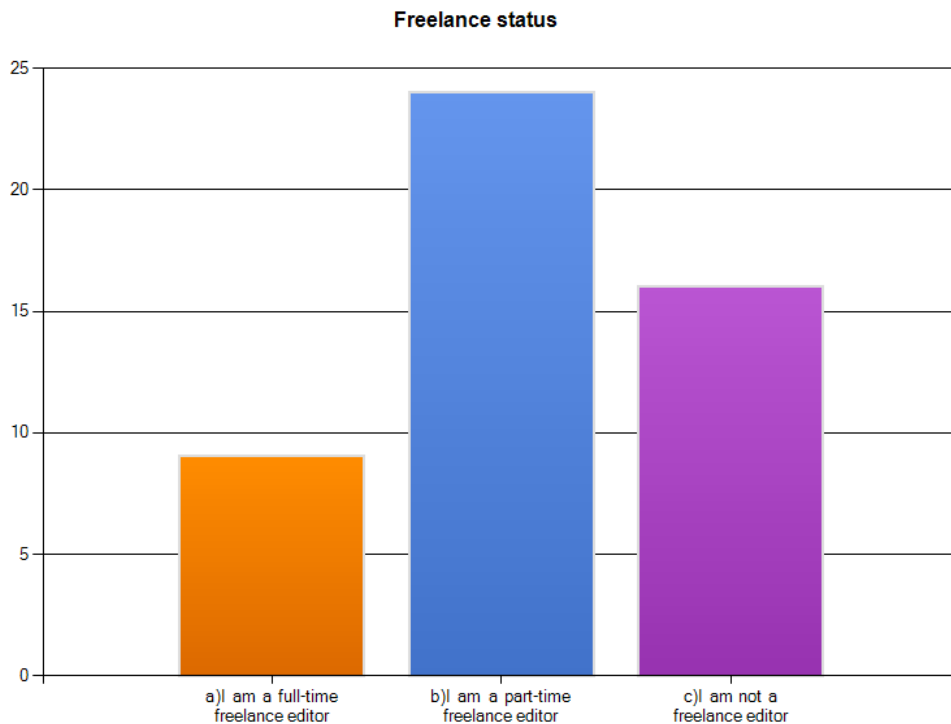
## 2013 Survey Results Summary

In June 2013 the CAFE board sent a survey to CAFE members and friends of the group. 50 people responded. Below is a summary of selected results for CAFE members and future members.

### Membership

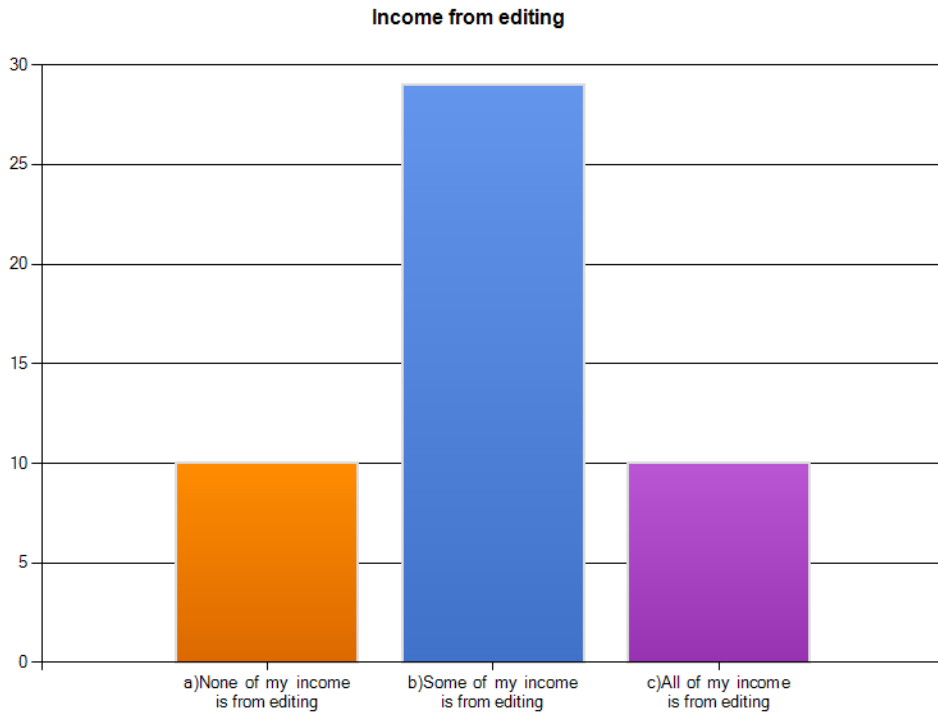
44% have been editing for more than 5 years, but 18% of the respondents aren't editors.

Almost half of the respondents are part-time freelancer editors, and only 18.4% are full-time.

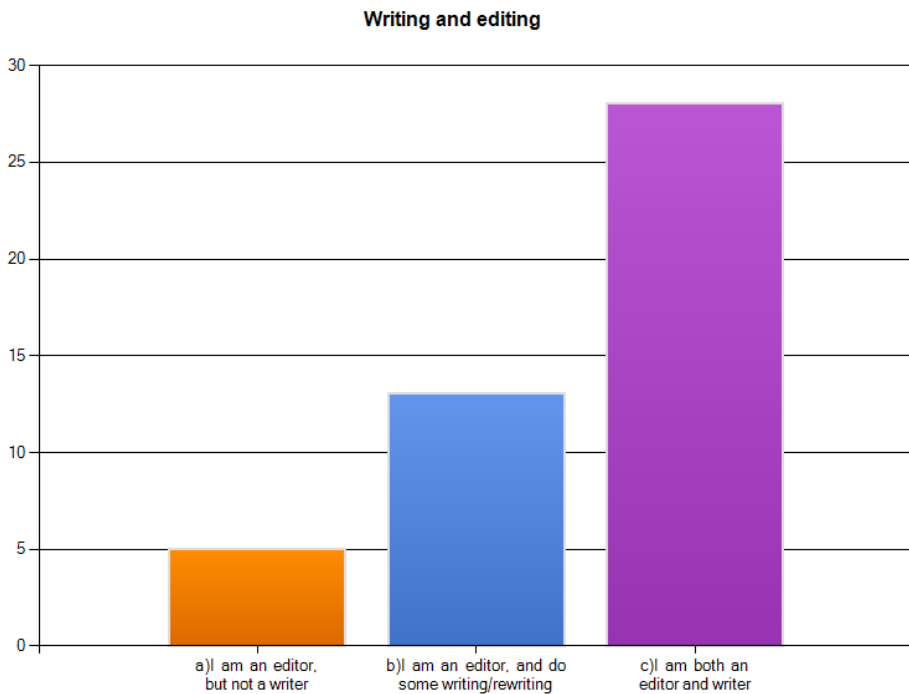


Some members that stated they were "not a freelance editor" indicated in their written responses that they worked in other fields like writing, translation, public relations, and document management to name a few, and while they may have editing tasks associated with their job or role, they didn't classify themselves as "an editor." Other members indicated that they were "in-house" (usually full-time) editors.

20.14% earn all their income from editing.



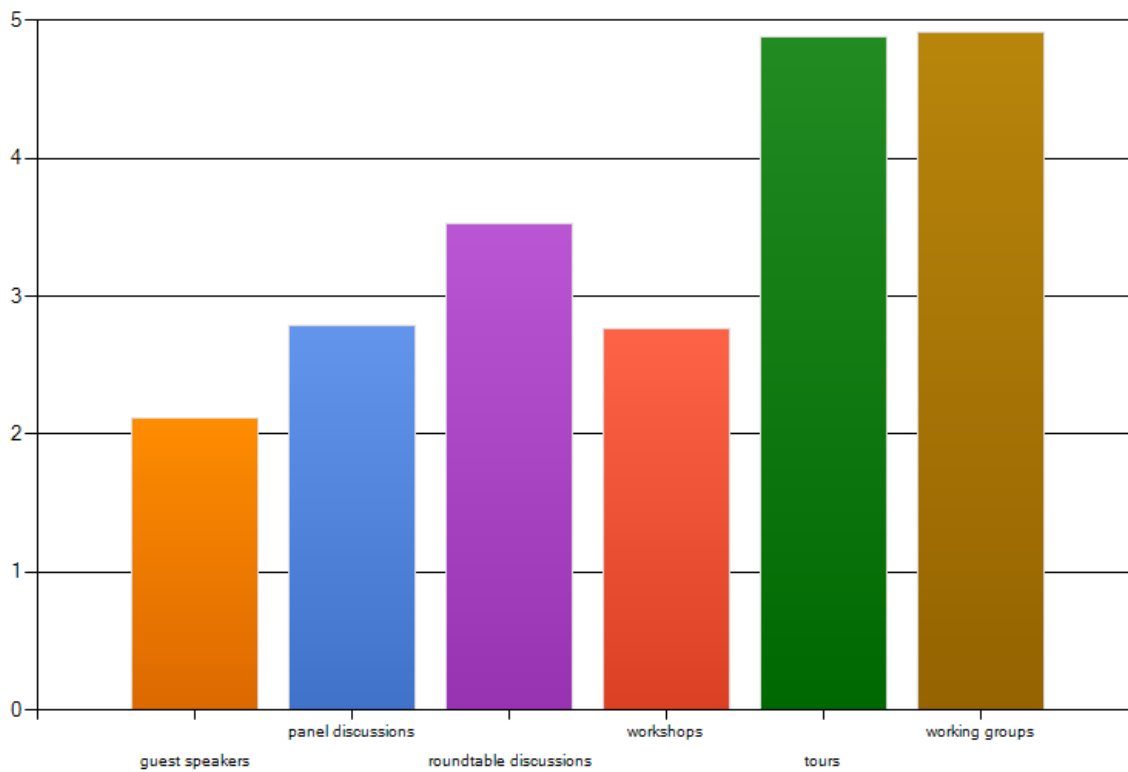
64.4% are both editors and writers.
